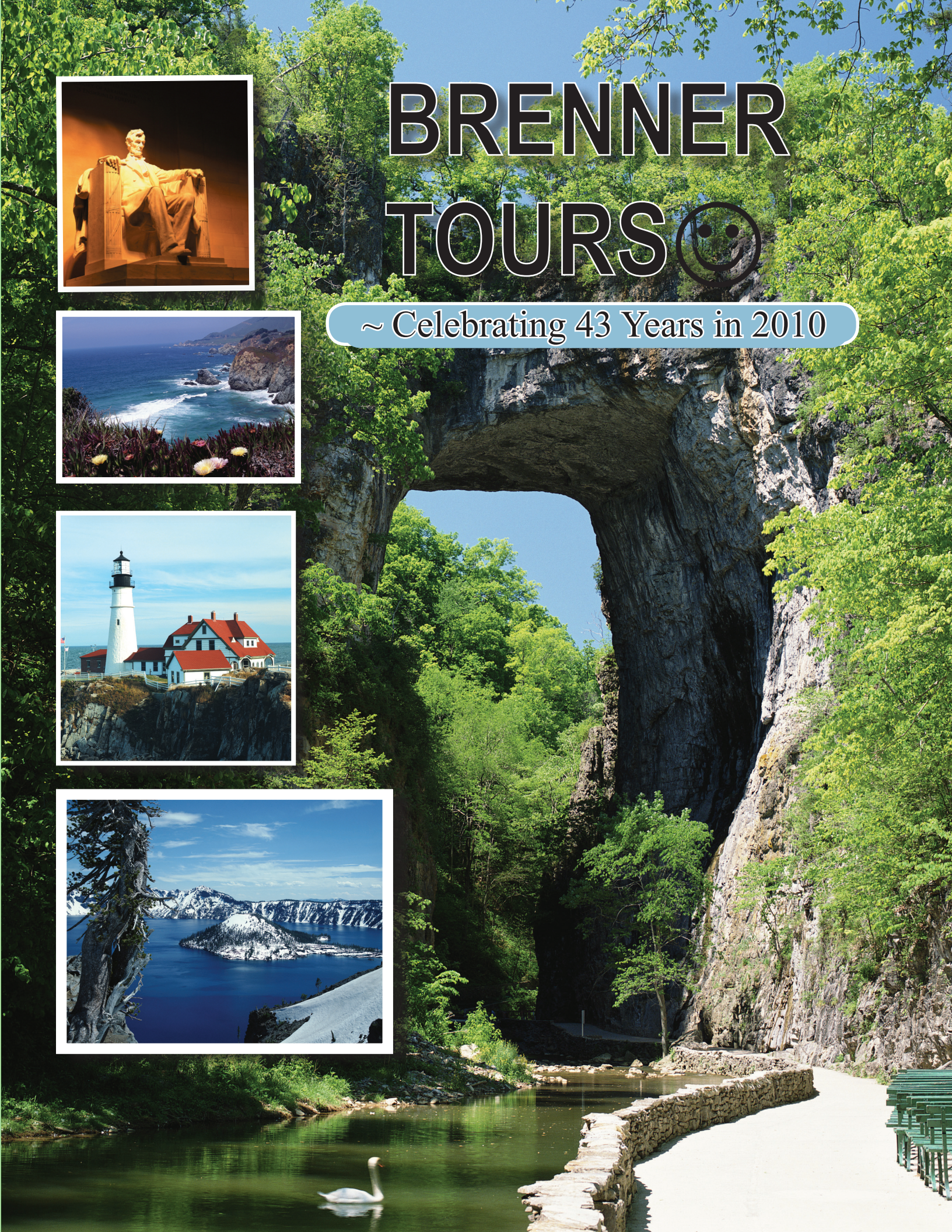
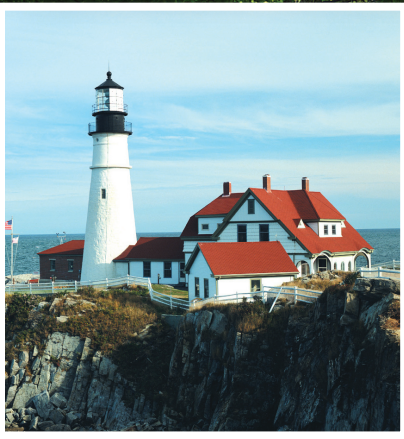
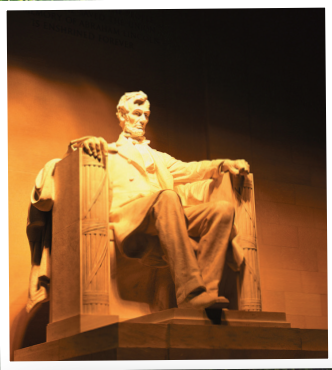

Day 1 Follow the Sun

We leave behind the snow and cold of Old Man Winter and get our Kicks on Route 66 to our first nights stop in Missouri. Enjoy the amenities of hotel including a delicious 5:30 Kickback where there's something for everyone! A snack for some, a meal for others, it's fun! (Kickback)

Day 2 it's OK in Oklahoma!

Our westward route through the rolling hills of Missouri and the fertile red soil of Oklahoma lead us west in search of the Valley of the Sun. (CB, L)

Day 3 Keep the Wagons Rollin'

With a great big "Howdy" we enter the Texas Panhandle. Seems everything is just a little bigger in Texas. Enter New Mexico with its vast array of scenic landscapes and beautiful

Day 4 Red Rocks and Sedona Snoozing

Drift the high plains of New Mexico which leads us to higher elevations with majestic stands of Douglas Fir and other hardwood trees. Cross the Great Divide and come to rest in simply amazing Sedona, the heart of Red Rock Country. The cliffs and spires which form this area provide stunning scenery of the city of Sedona, originally a pioneer settlement, now a thriving year round resort destination. The surrounding scenery has been used as a backdrop for literally hundreds of western movies and Zane Grey novels. Our modern wagon train brings us to our overnight stop in Cottonwood. (CB)

Day 5 Simply Amazing Scenery

Join us if you wish at a local church service this morning, then it's "All Aboard" the Verde River Canyon Excursion Train for a panoramic rail experience to Arizona's "other" Grand Canyon, accessible only by this railway. Your first-class accommodations includes snacks and hors d'oeuvres. The flora and fauna and high desert rock are a distinctive part of this area. Our train rolls past looming crimson cliffs, near Indian ruins, over towering bridges and through a 680-foot tunnel. This afternoon we reach our destination in the Valley of the Sun. (CB, Snacks and Hors d'oeuvres)

Day 6 Getting to Know the Valley

A local guide joins us for a look at Phoenix and the valley of the sun area. Some of the many highlights are the downtown area, with its impressive modern buildings and skyscrapers, the State Capital building and the impressive view of the distant Camelback Mountains. Our guide explains the legends and lore of this area and also keeps us informed on the many types of flowers, trees and fauna we see. The surrounding cities that border Phoenix are just as impressive with chic Scottsdale leading the way. Frank Lloyd Wright designed the impressive Grady Grammage Auditorium on the beautiful campus of ASU. You have a free afternoon to relax or go for a swim before joining us at the Barleen Family Country Music Theater. A delicious home cooked meal is served tableside, then relax and kick up your heels and clap your hands and sing along to the great country western, gospel and patriotic music. (Hot Breakfast, D)

Day 7 Tortilla Flats and Superstition Mountain Sightseeing

Another day is here, and you have this morning to put your feet up and set a spell. Don't get too comfortable though as the day ahead promises fun, surprises and great scenery! Travel to Tortilla Flats for an exciting cruise on beautiful Canyon Lake, one of Arizona's most spectacular desert lakes formed by the Salt River. Canyon Lake twists for about 10 miles through a magnificent gorge, ending at Horse Shoe Dam. See the wildlife and unique desert plants in their natural habitat. Back on land, our thoughts turn to food and tonight's meal at the Mining Camp Restaurant and Trading Post. This mining camp sits at the base of the Superstition Mountains. Enjoy heaping helpings of chicken, beef, and finger lickin' good all you can eat ribs. (Hot Breakfast, D)



Day 8 Continuing the Journey

We leave the Phoenix area today, following the interstate route to the culturally diverse city of Tucson. With over 3800 hundred hours of sunshine each year it's easy to see why so many people journey here. This was once a floor of a high desert sea and is surrounded by mountains on all side. Enjoy our narrated tram ride in Sabino Canyon as we view the surrounding walls of the canyon. On our visit to the Pima Air and Space Museum we view over 250 vintage aircraft, including the DC-6 used by Presidents Kennedy and Johnson. You are free this evening to enjoy the amenities of your hotel. (Hot Breakfast)

Day 9 Cacti or Cactus?



One of Tucson's most visited attractions is Saguaro National Park and the Arizona Sonora Desert Museum. Enjoy our drive through eight miles of the Saguaro and marvel at their unique shapes, sizes, and form. At the museum, you are able to see exhibits of over 300 live animal species, including mountain lions, Gila monsters, hawks, bighorn sheep and many others in their natural habitat. A 2 mile path leads us through landscapes containing more than 1,300 species of plants indigenous to this desert region. Later this afternoon our path leads us to Mission San Xavier Del Bac, called the "White Dove of the Desert" by the locals. This impressive structure is especially noted for its interior murals and the altar.

Here you can also shop for Native American Indian homemade jewelry and items made by the Indians who live at the mission. Before returning to our hotel, enjoy dinner at a local eatery. (CB, D)

Day 10 Must we leave so soon!

Already our thoughts turn east, but there is much to see and do. The impressive moon rock like scenery is followed by ancient lava flows and high desert road scapes that keep the miles clicking by. Near Alamogordo, we visit the White Sands National Monument. This impressive site is actually gypsum which is dissolved by the rain and melting snow from the surrounding mountains which sometimes form some 60 feet high above the desert floor. Our trail ends this evening in the heart of New Mexico hills. (CB)

Day 11 Carlsbad and the Panhandle

A great way to start our day is at Carlsbad Caverns National Park. You will be amazed at the sights you see, which showcases a series of enormous rooms that make up the park. We make our way to the Texas panhandle this evening. (CB, Kickback!)

Day 12 A Great Day to Say Thanks!

After attending a local church the interstate again leads us east. In Oklahoma City, we pause to view the Oklahoma National Memorial Museum, before continuing on our route. (CB)

Day 13 Praying Hands and Precious Days

We make a quick stop at ORU to view impressive praying hands. In Carthage we visit the Precious Moments Chapel, and enjoy a lunch at Lamberts Threwed Rolls on our journey to Fenton for our last overnight stop (CB, L, and Kickback!)

Day 14 All Good things must End.

Our trail and paths have come full circle, the memories of natures many wonders and the fun we have experienced will be long remembered! (CB)

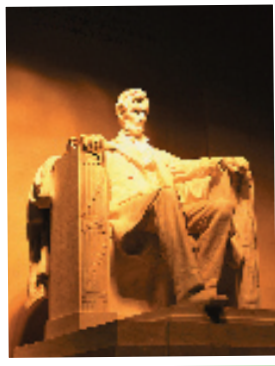
Day 1. We're on our way to relive some of the history of our nation and feel the excitement as we explore and learn about the inside and outside of our country's most important cities. Washington DC offers all of us a great opportunity to appreciate the importance our countries proud and profound history. Walk in the footsteps of America's heroes, remember the supreme sacrifice that many have paid, and come face to face with timely reminders You will experience a dose of incredible reality and awe as realize you are in America's past, her present and the hope of of a great future. We travel the first day to our overnight in the Keystone State.

Day 2 The Battle of Gettysburg forever changed the course of United States history. The most decisive battle in the course of the Civil War, today the battlefield is marked with monuments and headstones which paint a vivid and colorful picture of the battle for the Union. It was here that Lincoln delivered his

famous Gettysburg Address. At the newly renovated Visitors Center we view the exhibits and meet our guide who will present the Battle of Gettysburg in detail. You will feel like you are in the middle of the conflict as your guide recalls the battle and presents the facts. Lunch is included today, and then we must strike a path for our overnight stop in the Washington DC area, where we can unpack for the next 3 nights. This evening we enjoy a tour of the beautiful monuments in the DC area, illuminated and set amidst the impressive DC skyline. (B, L)

Day 3 Visit the White House Visitors Center, and take a short walk where we can take pictures of the residence of the First Family. The Capital Visitors Center allows the chance to learn about this impressive

building and view the equally impressive and beautiful Capital



Rotunda. To really appreciate this impressive building, we've arranged a special tour to see the Senate and House Chambers plus see some of the offices of the legislatures. Enjoy a lunch today in the Historic Mt. Vernon Inn. At Arlington National Cemetery, we board the Tourmobile Sightseeing Tram for a narrated visit to see the somber Tomb of the Unknown Soldier and witness the changing of the guard. We also visit the Kennedy burial site and the eternal flame, and see the Women in



Military Memorial Display. (B, L)

Day 4 Washington National Cathedral

sits impressively atop a hill overlooking the DC

metroplex. We visit this shrine this morning noting the beautiful Rose Windows and the Great Organ. A local guide joins us for the rest of the day showing such sights as the Naval Observatory, home of the Vice President, Embassy Row, learn about Watergate, see the Kennedy Center for the performing Arts, learn more of the history of DC, and visit Fords Theatre and Peterson House, the FBI building, the Capital Complex featuring the Supreme Court and the Library of Congress.

(Please note) Due to stringent security measures needed to protect our national treasures and buildings we must be prepared to walk to see these buildings. Wear appropriate comfortable walking shoes.

Of course we will again see the monuments by day and night as our guide provides insight and tells us about



Day 5 This morning you may visit the Holocaust Museum, and then it's your choice of the Smithsonian's many museums. This day is devoted for you to see the museum of your choice, with a collection of artifacts and objects numbering over 142 million. It includes the Air and Space Museum, the National Museum of American History, the Arts and Industries Museum, and the Museum of the American Indian. You will have lunch on your own as you enjoy the sights of the Smithsonian.

This afternoon we must begin our journey home. (B)

Day 6 September 11, 2001 is still another date that will be remembered in history by both the attacks upon American soil as well as the heroic actions taken by those who ultimately paid the supreme sacrifice. In the rolling hills of Pennsylvania we pause to remember and pay our respects to the heroes of Flight 93. As you gaze over the grassy fields you can visually follow the flight of the jet to the crash site. Over 150,000 visitors annually visit each year. As we travel home, we return with many memories from this tour to Gettysburg and Washington DC. (CB)

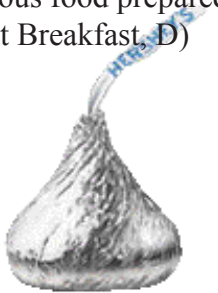

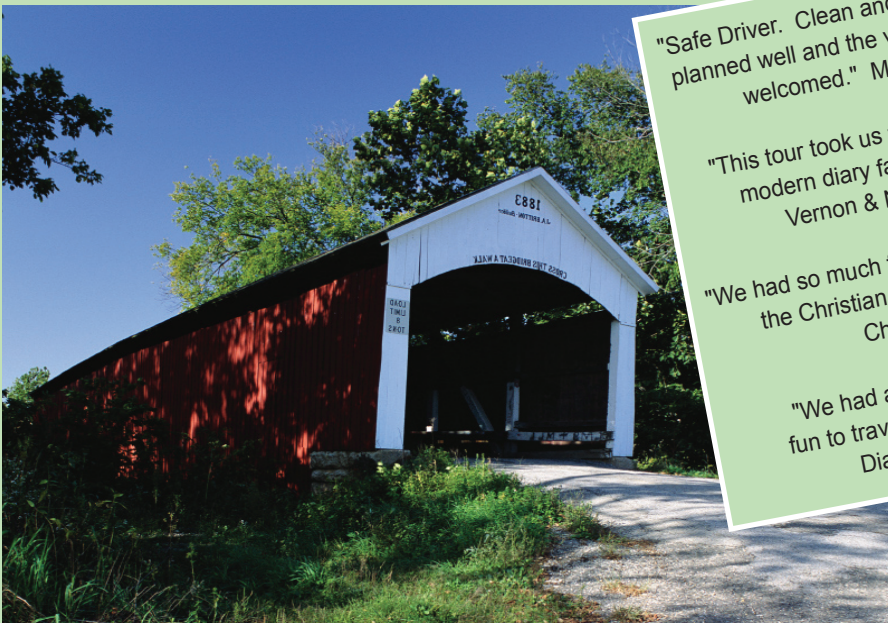

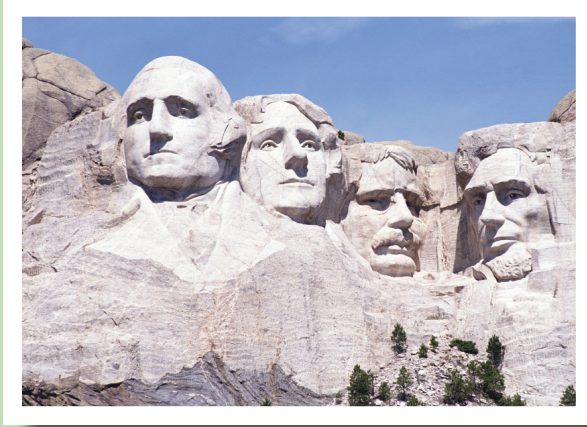

Day 1. Lets load our stagecoach and head west just like the pioneers and cross the fertile lands of Illinois and Iowa to our overnight stop where a delicious dinner waits. (D)

Day 2. Follow the route of the early settlers, visiting the Great Platte River Road Archway which depicts the lives of Native American Indians, the early settlers, and the trailblazing pioneers who carved a path on the Oregon Trail. (CB)

Day 3. South Dakota has a treasure trove of sights. Let's get a head start on our journey. We visit Chimney Rock National Historical Site, which guided the pioneers on the Oregon Trail. In Hot Springs we visit a Wild Horse Sanctuary where herds of wild horses and foals roam the land. Mammoth Site is some 26,000 years old, believed to be a sink hole where herd of wild animals would get trapped on the slippery slopes, eventually dying. (CB)

Day 4 Start another day of exploring and enjoying the sights of the Black Hills, beginning with our visit to Custer State Park. Board your jeep for a ride to view the large herd of buffalo that roam the park. Enjoy an included lunch at the historic State Park Lodge before heading to Mt. Rushmore to view the monument, which

features the achievements of the United States during 150 years of being a nation. Continue on to Keystone to learn about Mt. Rushmore through the eyes of Gutzon Borglum, the sculptor of Rushmore. Return to Mt. Rushmore and view the nightly illumination of the monument, before retiring for the evening at our overnight accommodations to enjoy a 2-night stay. (CB, L)

Day 5 Our first stop this morning is at Stavkirke, a 600 year old replica of a Danish Chapel. We step back to the Wild West with a visit to Deadwood and Lead,

sights of these western hill towns. The Gold Rush brought many settlers all looking for the chance to strike it rich. Names like Calamity Jane, Wild Bill Hickok, Wyatt Earp, and Doc Holiday all made up just some of the rip-roaring past of this era gone by. Notice how these gold boom towns cling to the side of the hills. At the Broken Boot Gold Mine you may pan for gold from this mine which produced gold from 1876 through the early 1900's.
